When you are sure: She looks like her mother. She looks exactly like her mother.
She doesn't look a bit like her mother.
She looks somewhat like her mother.
She looks a little bit like her mother.

Who do you think this person is?

When you are sure, you can use the verb "is":

He is young. He's a professor.

When you're guessing, you use "looks like":

She looks + adjective She looks bookish. She looks middle class.

She looks like + noun, phrase She looks like a librarian. She looks like she's middle class.
It looks like rain. It looks like it's going to rain.
